#### Panel data has been updated (2)

This time, we will talk about the current situation in Japan.

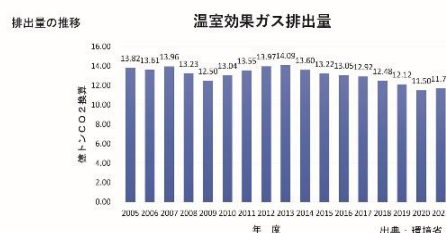
The Japanese government has set a goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 46% from 2013 by 2030. In 2020, amid the coronavirus pandemic, global CO2 emissions decreased by 6.4% compared to the previous year, while Japan's emissions decreased by 3.7%. By comparison, the number in the United States decreased by 8.8%.

Also, in 2021, the International Energy Agency (IEA) reported that global carbon dioxide emissions, which had fallen significantly in 2020, rebounded significantly in 2021. In Japan, there was an increase of approximately 1% compared to the previous year. At this rate, it seems difficult to achieve the 2030 goal.

The global temperature continues to rise. As of 2020, it is said that the temperature has risen by 1.09°C compared to before. There is now 0.41 degrees Celsius left before the 1.5 degrees Celsius limit for temperature rise that will allow the global environment to return to its previous state. We all need to use our wisdom to overcome this difficulty so that we don't end up like the video produced by the United Nations (in which a dinosaur shouts in the United Nations chamber, "Are you planning to destroy yourself with your actions!")? is.

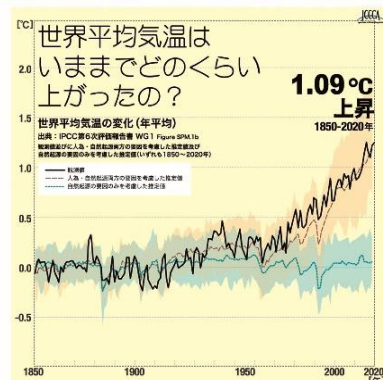
## 日本の現状

#### 排出量の推移



京都議定書が作られた2005年から15年以上経過していますが、増減を繰り返しているだけで、ほとんど排出量は減っていません。日本は、2030年で2013年比46%減少の目標を掲げていますが、このままの減少量では実現は困難な状況です。

#### 気温の上昇



2020年の時点で、以前と比べて1.09°C上昇していると言われています。地球環境を以前のように回復させることが出来る限界の気温上昇1.5℃まで、あと0.41℃となりました。
